

This year's track trek of course cannot easily take place as a physical event at the Railway, so instead we are running it as a virtual event. It is to raise money towards our **CV Emergency Appeal**. The idea is that you choose your own route of 4.5 miles, equivalent of the distance between Sheffield Park and Horsted Keynes (but you must not visit the Railway itself), which you **complete on 27 June** as part of the daily exercise permitted under the government's restrictions as in force at the time, and seek sponsorship from friends. **Please note:** Participants do so at their own risk and must adhere to the then current guidelines (including maintaining social distancing) and if they cannot they must not breach them to finish.
